Shirley and I will be leaving early morning of April 3rd for a journey that will take us from San Francisco through Taiwan to the Philippines. There we will be taking part in Philippine International Bible Institute graduations in Batangas and Olongapo. Shirley will also teach the ladies Bible class teachers in Angeles City. A review of school policies will be discussed with all four of the Philippine schools. Further relationships will be built with all of the schools and acquaintances will be renewed.

From the Philippines we will go to Thailand to attend a camp that draws hundreds of Christians from all over the country. We will be able to spend time with Patinya Thitathan who is the director of our associate school, Bangkok Servant Leadership, in Bangkok.

From our stay in Thailand we will go to Phnom Penh, Cambodia for four weeks of teaching in the Cambodia Bible Institute. I will be teaching a course on "The church in the book of Acts". Shirley will be teaching in the World English Institute run from the PIP house. All of these possibilities are thrilling to us as well as the many trips we will make into the country to see the people and visit the good works of missionaries and students from the school.
